



SMEs as new E-Invoicing users (1)




E-Invoice usage of small/mid-sized senders



SMEs as new E-Invoicing users (2)




E-Invoice usage of Spanish small/mid-sized senders








Electronic Invoice Exchange in companies of 7 EU countries

Trends for large organisations



Today	Next steps
Large trading parties already on board	SMEs, by considering their special situation regarding skills, systems, processes
Domestic trading parties	International suppliers/customers
Opt-In roll-out	Change to Opt-Out: Declare E- Invoicing as mandatory, sanctions for unwilling counterparts
Dematerialisation of invoices	Full integration & process automation
Proprietary solutions	International standards Standard features of ERP providers
Interconnection among service providers: limited number and based on bilateral solutions	Large accounts increase the pressure for improvement

Solutions for SMEs (1)



Rich offering for bilateral or service provider model is available:

- Users of accounting or ERP systems
 E-Invoice Management features integrated parts or Add-Ins (SAP, Microsoft, ...)
- Invoicing portals
 with modular packages, most with a limited number of
 free e-Invoices per months

Solutions for SMEs (2)




- Client software (comparable to Outlook) for inbound orders and outbound invoices, most with Purchase Order flip feature
- Printer drivers
- PDF Mailers with or without enrichments (signature, structured data mapping, etc.)
- Office Tools / Add-Ins, e.g. ebInterface (AT), WinDTE (CL), FactOffice (SP)

Obstacles for faster market development
